
DEMOLITION PILOT PROGRAM



The Demolition Program offers reimbursement grants of up to \$5,000 per property for removal and cleanup of dilapidated structures (e.g., house, garage, shed, etc.).

This is not an income-based program; anyone may qualify.





2023 LOCATIONS

The 2023 service locations include the following Kansas counties:

- Cheyenne
- Decatur
- Gove

Assistance is available on a first-come, first-served basis. Funding is limited on a per county basis.

MODERATE INCOME HOUSING REHABILITATION **PILOT PROGRAM**



The Moderate Income Housing Rehabilitation Program offers reimbursement grants of up to \$10,000 to homeowners in eligible

counties to complete minor housing upgrades (e.g., roofing, siding, or heating and air units, etc.).

Homeowner must provide 10% of project total up to \$1,000.

Rental properties are not eligible for this program. Self-help (homeowner supplying the needed labor with the program supplying reimbursement for materials) is allowed.

Households must meet moderate income guidelines outlined in the program application to be eligible to apply.
