MODERATE INCOME HOUSING REHABILITATION PILOT PROGRAM

Administered by North Central Regional Planning Commission through a partnership with the Dane G. Hansen Foundation

About the Program

The Moderate Income Housing Rehabilitation Pilot Program offers **reimbursement** grants up to \$10,000 to homeowners in eligible counties to complete minor housing upgrades. This program is intended to help preserve housing stock that is often underserved by other assistance programs.

Who is Eligible

2025 eligible service locations include the following Kansas counties:

Ellsworth, Saline (located outside Salina city limits)*, Sheridan, Thomas, Trego, and Wallace

*Saline County locations must be outside the boundaries of the City of Salina

- Assistance is available on a first come, first served basis. Funding is limited on a per county basis.
- Households must meet moderate income guidelines to be eligible to apply. Proof of the household income will
 be determined from the 2024 annual tax form 1040* using adjusted gross income guidelines listed in the table
 below. For example, a family of five (5) must have an adjusted gross income between \$75,000 and \$148,500 to
 qualify. For families larger than eight, contact NCRPC for income qualifications.

*Copy of Form 1040, U.S. Individual Income Tax Return(s), for the 2024 tax year (excluding schedules) is required. *If taxes are in extension, then ineligible.

Allowable Projects

- Examples of eligible housing upgrades: roofing, siding, electrical, A/C, furnace, foundation repair, windows, etc.
 This list is not exhaustive. Check the <u>Frequently Asked Questions</u> for more information. For project specific questions, email NCRPC Housing Director Keegan Bailey at housing@ncrpc.org.
- Must be primary residence.

Project Exclusions

- Ineligible grant rehabilitation: appliances, window blinds, cameras, solar panels, new construction or additions, fencing, driveways, landscaping, shade structures, patio covers, and gazebos/pergolas. This list is not exhaustive. For project specific questions, email NCRPC Housing Director Keegan Bailey at housing@ncrpc.org.
- Rental properties are not eligible for this program.
- No tool purchases will be allowed for reimbursement.

Self-Help

If self-help is utilized rather than a contractor, **material only** will be reimbursed and proof of payment will be required. Self-help is defined as the homeowner supplying the needed labor with the program supplying reimbursement for materials. A 10% match is still required.

Moderate Income Housing Rehabilitation Pilot Program

How it Works

- **Reimbursement** grants of up to \$10,000 to help with housing rehabilitation are available for qualified applicants.
- Homeowner must provide 10% of project total up to \$1,000. See Project Calculation Examples section below.
- Homeowners must certify their commitment to provide the 10% match, as well as pay any costs above and beyond the \$10,000 grant.
- The North Central Regional Planning Commission (NCRPC) will provide a reimbursement after proof of payment to the contractor, financial institution, or material supplier has been received.
- Selection of a contractor and coordination of rehabilitation work is up to the homeowner(s). NCRPC is **NOT** involved with that process. Self-help is also allowed (see page 1). **No tools; material only!**
- All expenditures must be made after August 1, 2025.
- Rehabilitation project must be complete within 90 days after the application is approved by the NCRPC.
- Owner must provide before and after proof of complete project and photographs of the improvements to receive the grant funding. All properties are subject to random audit by NCRPC staff prior to reimbursement.

Project Calculation Examples

The following examples illustrate how the grant reimbursement/homeowner match amounts are calculated.

Furnace Upgrade Project:

\$8,750 - Total project cost

\$7,875 - Moderate Income Housing Rehabilitation Program reimbursement grant

\$875 - 10% Homeowner match up to \$1,000

Window Replacement Project:

\$15,000 - Total project cost

\$10,000 - Moderate Income Housing Rehabilitation Program reimbursement grant maximum

\$1,000 - 10% Homeowner match up to \$1,000

\$4,000 - Additional amount paid by homeowner to cover the project costs above the \$10,000 grant

Additional NCRPC Housing Services Available

Application Checklist

All items must be submitted to process your application.

	Completed application (Page 4)		
	Proof of household income for all occupant(s) age 18 & older. Copy of Form 1040, U.S. Individual Income Tax Return(s), for the 2024* tax year (excluding schedules). *If taxes are in extension, then ineligible. Adjusted gross income is used to determine eligibility.		
	Verification of property ownership – <i>Copy</i> Deed must be registered at the Register of Deeds Office in property owner(s) name.		
	Verification of most recent paid real estate taxes – <i>Copy</i> Need receipt of 1st half or full payment of property taxes paid in December and/or May. This can be obtained from the County Treasurer's Office.		
	A "before" color photo of project. A final "after" color photo showing the project from the same angle will be required for reimbursement.		
Application Disclaimer: NCRPC reserves the right to request additional documentation to determine eligibility. Should this additional documentation not be supplied, an application will be denied.			

Signed Application Certifications

Within 10 days of submitting an application and the supporting documentation listed in the checklist above, the original Application Certifications will need to be received by NCRPC to retain your reserved slot.
